Cognitive-behavioral therapy in the face of contemporary challenges


*The conference will take place in Krakow, Poland, and online on ZOOM platform, **13th-15th of May, 2022***



Oral presentations

We invite researchers and clinicians to submit abstracts of presentations on a theoretical or clinical problem, research results, or case studies. Presenters are obliged to attend the relevant presentation session. The time limit for presentations is 20 minutes (including discussion). For presentations in English, please submit the abstracts in both Polish and English.


Any details that could facilitate patient identification in presentations, including case studies, must be removed or altered to maintain anonymity.



The first author needs to ensure that all co-authors have agreed to the presentation of their results. The presentation schedule and speech guidelines will be announced once a submission has been accepted by the Advisory Scientific Committee of the Conference. Submitted abstracts should include the following details:

- *Author biography*
- *Abstract (maximum 500-700 words)*

Workshops


We invite clinicians and applied researchers to submit abstracts of therapeutic skills workshops lasting three hours and one and a half hours, as well as a one-hour demonstration of techniques and skills application. Workshops should be suitable for practitioners with varied clinical experience. Workshops will be conducted in parallel in specified time slots. Submitted abstracts should include the following details:

- *Workshop title*
- *Workshop conductor name*
- *Workshop conductor affiliations*
- *Abstract (maximum 500 words)*
- *Workshop method (e.g. PowerPoint presentation, video, exercises, role-playing)*
- *Workshop goals and practical skills that workshop participants can apply in their everyday clinical practice*
- *Conductor biography*

Posters

We invite clinicians, researchers, and students to submit clinical posters, showing the preliminary results of an ongoing study or case study. Poster will be presented in electronic form. Any details that could facilitate patient identification in presentations, including case studies, must be removed or altered to maintain anonymity.

The first author needs to ensure that all co-authors have agreed to the presentation of their results. The presentation schedule and poster guidelines will be announced once a submission has been accepted by the Advisory Scientific Committee of the Conference. Submitted abstracts should include the following details:
